ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

Johanna Mirabel's painting develops in delicate layers where characters are superimposed, creating a story that is both eloquent and inexplicable. This desire to evoke atmospheres and recreate emotions without explicitly representing or explaining them is influenced by Edouard Glissant's ideas. Particularly, Glissant's concept of the right to opacity is crucial for an artist who subtly explores the construction of identity in her large-format works, applying iron oxide priming techniques reminiscent of those used by Velazquez and other European Baroque masters.
