## ARTIST BIOGRAPHY

McArthur Binion creates unique, labor-intensive works that blend minimalism, identity politics, and abstraction. He uses materials such as oil paint stick, ink, and graphite to create detailed grids over personal photographs and documents. These archival elements provide insight into his life and experiences, including his birth certificate, childhood home, and early years in New York. Binion's work, influenced by poetry and jazz, combines improvisation with structure, and personal narrative with the broader history of Black Abstraction. His pieces defy simple classification, reflecting both critique and acceptance of minimalist art.
